The Prayerbook Rebellion, 1549

On 16th August, 1549 a royalist Army stayed overnight in Crediton. They were pursuing the remnants of the rebel army they had crushed in a battle near Exeter. Hundreds – possibly thousands – of defeated combatants had fled west. The royalists were hunting them down.

What must that have been like?

On the 475<sup>th</sup> anniversary of that day, we will walk through the town, looking at what we know about the Prayerbook Rebellion, and how it affected local people and places.
