REBELLION IN CREDITON (PART 2)

The Prayerbook Rebellion, 1549

On 16th August, 1549 a royalist Army stayed overnight in Crediton. They were pursuing the remnants of the rebel army they had crushed in a battle near Exeter. Hundreds – possibly thousands – of defeated combatants had fled west. The royalists were hunting them down.

What must that have been like?

On the 475th anniversary of that day, we will walk through the town, looking at what we know about the Prayerbook Rebellion, and how it affected local people and places.
